How To Set Up Your Annual S.O. Payment

If you wish to pay your yearly membership by S.O. please contact your bank to fill out the appropriate Standing Order form.

Our banking details are below and if you would kindly use your full name as a reference, this will help us tie up your membership paperwork.

It would also be very helpful if you could set up your S.O. to recur annually on April 30th.

Alternatively, you can pay by bank transfer as a direct credit, but please remember this covers one year's subscription and needs renewing annually.

Ongoing Work In Our Parish

- * We campaign alongside our members to preserve our Green Belt for the enjoyment of future generations.
- * We liaise with the Parish Council and SCANGB over responses to major planning issues.
- * We work with Northaw Action Group (NAG) re: HGV congestion and unauthorised developments in Northaw.
- * We continue to oppose the implementation of the WHBC's Local Plan - which threatens our already overstretched local infrastructure and services.
- * We campaign about the inadequacy of highways as new housing numbers continue to increase.

Recent Planning Applications NCRA Has Fought Together With The Parish Council, SCANGB & NAG

- * Starling Lane -We have successfully opposed development on the 'Pedestrian Only Footpath'.
- * The Ridgeway - Inappropriate housing development refused for nine houses.
- * Wood Green Timber - Together with the lead campaign group, Northaw Action Group (NAG), we continue to oppose the erection of the huge racking/storage system built without planning consent and within the Green Belt.

NCRA Services To Members

- * Represent residents' views at Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council (WHBC) planning hearings and appeals.
- * Liaise with Highways - to improve local footways.
- * Support residents anti fly tipping campaign.
- * Hold monthly public meetings and a public AGM for members, together with a stand at the Village Day.
- * Signpost members towards official sources of help.
- * Communicate with members via a variety of media including regular email updates on local issues and respond to members' queries and concerns.
